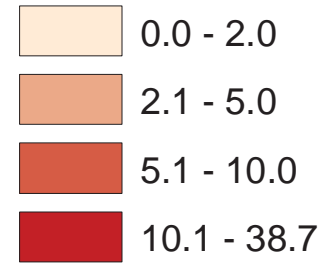


Excess Commuting

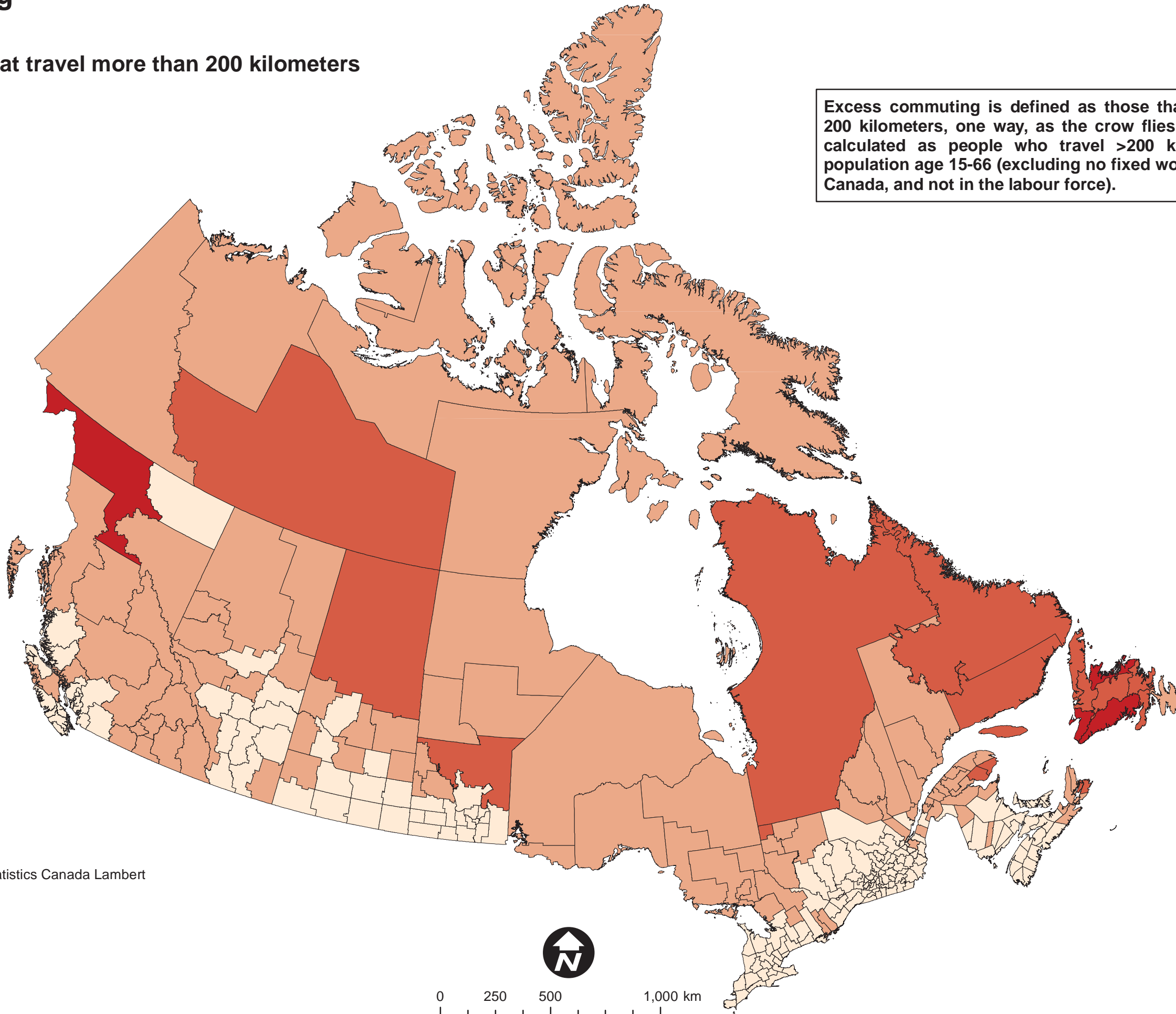

Excess commuting is defined as those that travel more than 200 kilometers, one way, as the crow flies. The proportion is calculated as people who travel >200 kilometers / overall population age 15-66 (excluding no fixed work place, outside of Canada, and not in the labour force).
