Her research interests include gender, work, mobility, integration processes and transnationalism. Her primary research in recent years has been concerned with diverse aspects of the international employment-related geographical mobility of workers from the Philippines and Poland to Iceland. In “**Diverse experiences of nurses from the Philippines in Iceland**” Dr. Skaptadóttir will present some results of her continuing research on migration of Filipinos to Iceland, with a focus on her current study about nurses and other health sector employees, considering the different conditions that affect their migration options as well as their views towards their work and migration.
